## **BURLINGTON FLOOD UPDATE**

Friday, July 14, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.

- Echo Lake Dam is being slowly drained over the next two weeks to keep the dam structurally sound and to keep water levels down river consistent.
- City of Burlington drinking water is safe. Well water in the flooded area may not be and should be tested with free kits from the Health Department ([crchd.com](http://crchd.com)). Bottled water is available at Gooseberry's and Burlington High School. Additional health and safety information for residents and businesses is also available on the webpage.
- We Energies is working to restore power to affected residents as quickly as possible and hopes to have it restored by Saturday.
- Do not drive in flooded areas.
- Aircraft are conducting damage surveys Friday afternoon so no drones are allowed.
- A curfew is in effect from 10:00 pm Friday to 6:00 am Saturday.
- Cash donations can be made at any BMO Harris bank under "Burlington Flood Relief Account". No other volunteers or donations are needed right now.
