Recognizing Hypothermia – 30 sec.

Hypothermia is a deadly condition that strikes during very cold weather or when people are chilled from rain, sweat or cold water. Shivering, exhaustion, confusion, fumbling hands, memory loss, slurred speech and drowsiness are signs of hypothermia. Babies with hypothermia have bright red, cold skin and very low energy.
