ADDITIONAL VOLUNTEER RECEPTION CENTERS TO OPEN TO ASSIST THOSE AFFECTED BY THE FLOOD

A United Way Volunteer Reception Center is being set up at the Pilgrim United Church of Christ located at 535 Stow Street in the City of Fond du Lac to register and assign volunteers to assist throughout the county, with the majority of the assistance needed in the City of Fond du Lac. The Volunteer Reception Center will be open Thursday, March 21st, 2019 from 12 pm – 3 pm and Saturday, March 23rd from 8:30 am – 3 pm. Volunteers should park in the main parking lot and enter the front door to begin the registration process. Volunteers should bring a form of identification as well as have appropriate cold and wet weather clothing. Volunteers are being requested to assist with carrying out items and cleaning up basements, among other things. We are also looking for volunteers to place phone calls, do other clerical work within the volunteer reception center and make deliveries as well.
